- Previous experience as a training or check captain (or equivalent qualification) on jet aircraft.
- Australian ATPL.
- Demonstrate above proficient non-technical skills and an in-depth understanding of the impact of human factors on performance.
- Display excellent interpersonal skills and communication abilities.
- Demonstrate an inclusive and respectful leadership qualities.
- Have a proven ability to work as part of a team.
- The ability to pass a CASA Class 1 Aviation Medical Certificate.
- A working knowledge of International standard regulations, industry guidance and requirements.
- Level 6 English language qualification on your licence.
- Maintain an exemplary standard of professionalism, integrity and ethics, along with a high standard of conduct and behaviour consistent with Qantas values.

Hour Requirements:

- Minimum 1000 hours PIC on A220 or similar generation 4 jet aircraft.
- Minimum 4000 hours total experience.
